### International Student Leaders Bursary

Only International students are eligible

**Open to:** International applicants from emerging markets globally (excluding USA, Canada, and countries within the EU) who are dedicated to contributing to their home country's economic development.

Candidates will be considered based on their **Personal Statement** where applicants must describe how undertaking the program of their choice will affect their career, educational, and personal goals. Candidates should also describe how they intend to contribute to the economic development of their country and what obstacles they will have to overcome.

**The scholarship tier and amount will be dependent on the strength of the student's application.**

**Award recipients will be expected to act as ambassadors for UCW and participate in outreach and alumni engagement initiatives in their home region once awarded.**

### 3. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- All students are eligible to apply for awards, using a single application. You must provide the requested supporting documentation. Incomplete award applications will not be considered.
- You need only apply once to be considered for awards for the duration of their studies with UCW. Once received, their application will be retained for consideration for subsequent award cycles.
- Recipients of financial awards must maintain registered status in the term following receipt of the award. If the recipient withdraws, the award will be refunded to UCW. Financial awards may not be transferred to another student. All the remaining fees must be paid before the start of the program.
- UCW will apply financial award monies first towards outstanding tuition fees owed to UCW. Financial awards may be deferred for a maximum of one (1) term only. You must make the request for a deferral in writing to Student Services. If you leave UCW during the period of the award, the monies shall be returned to UCW.
- The scholarship amount shall be deducted from your tuition fees throughout the entire study period with UCW, on a pro rata basis, and shall be deducted from the tuition fees annually.
- The scholarship is for the ONE named person and UCW will not be responsible for a scholar's family members/spouse/children etc
- In the event that a student does not attend a program through serious unforeseen circumstances (death, accident, or serious illness) the Awards committee will examine each case on an individual basis.
- Attendance is compulsory. An attendance rate of less than 90% will lead to scholarship withdrawal.
- Any failure to start the program as scheduled without prior notification of the UCW's authorities will lead to scholarship withdrawal.
- UCW may also use information collected regarding the scholars in the School marketing activities; however, students' addresses and telephone numbers will not be given out without permission from the student via a request from UCW.
- UCW may feature your interview/photo/profile/story on the UCW website and/or other School publications and will ask for your permission/approval prior to publishing this.
- Please note that official transcripts or approved credential evaluation report (WES or AACRO) will be required for evaluation originals (not photocopies) in evidence with their scholarship application, and present these to the Scholarship office, if there is any question of authenticity. If UCW discovers any documents that are NOT 100% genuine, the scholarship award will immediately be invalidated and withdrawn. UCW accepts NO liability in this case.
- It is the scholar's responsibility to set a good example, e.g. strive for best results, attend classes, finish the program on time and continue to demonstrate the exemplary student attributes/grades by which he/she was awarded the scholarship.
- Scholarship recipients of the Undergraduate program must maintain a GPA of 2.75 throughout the duration of the program. Scholarship recipients of the Graduate program must maintain a GPA of 3.0 throughout the duration of the program. Failure to maintain these grades will lead to a scholarship withdrawal.
- By invitation only, scholars will take part in welcoming new students to the scholarship program.
- The UCW Scholarship panel will not provide information regarding the non-awarding of scholarships and the panel's decision is final.
- UCW reserves the right to investigate and possibly withdraw a person from the scholarship program if there is adequate proven evidence of serious allegations of illegal activities.
